### • Board Bills (James)

- Short Term Rental (BB33)
  - Passed by BOA, Mayor's office has signed into law Nov 6th
  - Giving up to a year before process in full effect
- Surface Parking (BB44)
  - Dan spoke to Ald. Aldridge, who is getting ready to file it
  - Referred to the HUDZ committee in June 2023, but Aldridge is going to submit an amended revised copy
- Liquor License Process (BB60)
  - No news, still being worked on, sitting in Committee
  - Pres Green went over some of this during State of the City Address
  - May be waiting for Red Tape Commission to expire
- Homeless Bill of Rights
  - City had two hearings about it, but may not move on it until 2024
- Neighborhood Alliance (Dan/James)
  - Trying to connect with other Neighborhoods / have more dialogue
  - About 15 to 20 solid members

- Added commercial districts like South Grand Loop, Laclede's Landing, East Loop

- Happened at Soulard Station (Tucker & Well)

  - Future Town Hall Speakers
    - Darby Latham from Great Rivers Greenway wants to present updates in March 2024, especially since Jan 2024 is for elections

## • DNA Board Elections in January (Dan)

- Happening on Jan 8th Town Hall
- Will advertise at least 30 days in advance
- Earline, Justin, and Jace's seats are up, LaShana is not re-running
- Candidates have to be a member for at least one year and dues up to date
- Kristin's seat will possibly be up in mid-2024
- Deadline for candidacy is Jan 1 (7 days before elections)

### • DNA Holiday Party 12/14/23 (James)

- Has a subcommittee working on party (Shane, Michelle B, Dan, and James)
- Met yesterday evening at TechArtista to review plan

- Piano player recommended from previous person we used, agreed to \$200 for entire night and will bring their own equipment

- Rosalita's catering for food: estimated 80 people, self-serve; \$921.51 (includes delivery, utensils, plates, food warmers, etc.); complimentary signature drink upon arrival, wine from DNA reserves, cash bar; prizes raffled throughout evening - Motion to approve up to \$1,500 in total expenses for holiday party (moved by

Earline, seconded by LaShana, unanimously approved)

- Membership Blitz (Kristin)
  - No updates at this time, will get back to it in 2024
- Membership Audit Status (Kristin)
  - We have 85 responses for the membership audit (matches with amount last year)
  - Still have another month for completion
  - 47 transactions (including some donations above membership amount)
- Letter of Support for 400 S. 14th
  - Ald. Aldridge and members of Condo Associations were in support
  - Will be rebranded as a Sheraton
  - Murals will be updated/refreshed
  - Several units will be reserved as actual apartments (long-term rentals)

- Safety (Dan)
  - Conducted on Nov 29th
  - No real updates, mostly quiet
  - May change location to Hotel Saint Louis in 2024, upon inquiry by former board member Corey James
- Building Captains (Dan/James)
  - Chair asked for ideas to generate more engagement
